1. Rules

1.1. The regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). Appendix S will apply. RRS 61 is changed to require a competitor to inform the race committee's finish boat of his intention to protest, including the sail number of the protested boat, immediately after finishing. RRS 63.7 is replaced with: "If there is a conflict between a rule in the notice of race and one in the sailing instructions, the sailing instructions shall apply."

2. Eligibility and Entry

2.1. The Ironman regatta is open to Optimists skippered by boys 8 to 15 years of age. There will be Optimist green; Optimist blue, white, and red fleets; Laser Radials and 4.7's; Sunfish; and club 420s skippered and crewed by boys who have not reached their 19th birthday. 3. Fees

3.1. The required fee is \$70 for single-handed boats and \$110 for double-handed boats. There will be a \$10 on site registration fee. The fee includes breakfast, lunch and tee shirt.

4. Schedule:

4.1. Thursday July 11

- 0800 to 0915 Check In
- 0930 Contestants' Meeting
- 1015 First Warning Signal for All Classes, races to follow.
- Awards to follow racing

5. Races

5.1. Five races are planned for each of the fleets. One race constitutes a regatta.

6. Venue

6.1. Green fleet will sail outside the clubhouse on Kettle Creek. Lasers/Sunfish/Club 420 will sail on the Green Island course. R/W/B Optimists will also sail on the Green Island course

7. Sailing Instructions

7.1. Sailing Instructions will be available on-line prior to the regatta. Limited copies will be available at check-in.

8. Courses

8.1. The courses used will be windward/leeward, triangle, or Olympic.

9. Scoring

9.1. The low point scoring system of Appendix A will apply. If five or more races are completed, each boat's worst score will be excluded from her series score. This changes Rule A2.

10. Support Boats

10.1. Support boats will not be allowed to launch using the hoist after 0800 on July 11. All those launching before 0800 will have to move their car and trailer off the property to allow for access to the beach and hoist. There is a 1,500 pound limit on the hoist.

11. Automobiles

11.1. All cars will be required to park outside the club property. Those dropping off boats will be asked to "drop and go".

12. Responsibility for Safety

12.1. Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in Ironman Regatta are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, and any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race officers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

13. SAYC Goes Green!

13.1. We will not be providing plastic water bottles to sailors. Bring your own refillable water bottle!

14. Food Available for Spectators

14.1. The Shore Acres grill and bar will be open, and food and beverages will be available for purchase.

15. Clubhouse Entry

15.1. Entry into the clubhouse for sailors will be restricted and use of the elevator will not be allowed unless medically required. Current NJ state regulations impose no numerical limit on indoor or outdoor gatherings.

16. Liability Waiver

16.1. All competitors will be required to complete the attached liability waiver.
